

RESOLUTION NO. 111521

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964
FOR THE TOWN OF INGALLS, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Federal Government enacted Title VI of the Civil Rights Act in 1964, as amended, to prevent discrimination on the grounds of race, color, sex, gender, disability, or national origin and to ensure that individuals are not excluded from participation in, denied benefits of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance on the basis of race, color, sex, age, gender, disability, or national origin; and

WHEREAS, throughout the years, additional regulations, statutes, directives, cases, and executive orders have been passed which expand the breadth of Title VI; and

WHEREAS, it is a requirement of the Indiana Department of Transportation and the U.S. Department of Transportation that communities receiving Federal financial assistance adopt a Title VI Plan.




